- C. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education promulgate rules to implement the program.
- D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a school district to pay a student's tuition or other associated costs for taking a course that is available through the program.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
