9	hunting and fishing landowner license; providing eligibility for license issuance; establishing
10	license fee; limiting total number of licenses issued; requiring certain evidence; defining terms;
11	and providing an effective date.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-113, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 4-113. A. Legal residents who are not the individuals
17	excepted from the license requirement as provided in subsection B of
18	Section 4-112 of this title may purchase an annual combination
19	hunting/fishing license from the Director or agents of the Director.
20	B. The fee for each combination hunting/fishing license issued
21	under this section shall be:
22	1. For legal residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for
23	a license that expires on December 31 of the year purchased - Forty-
24	one Dollars (\$41.00);

2. For residents eighteen (18) years of age and older for a
license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year purchased Fifty-two Dollars (\$52.00);

- 3. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of age for a license that expires on December 31 of the year purchased Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00); and
- 4. For legal residents sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of age for a license that expires on June 30 of the fiscal year purchased Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00).
- C. Of the fees collected pursuant to the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section, Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the license fee shall be for the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp and shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund created pursuant to the provisions of Section 4-141 of this title.
- D. Legal residents and nonresidents may purchase an annual combination hunting and fishing landowner license; provided, the license shall only be valid for hunting and fishing on the land for which it was purchased. The license provided for in this subsection may be issued to the landowner's or tenant's siblings and lineal ascendants or descendants, and their spouses, whether or not an Oklahoma resident. The license fee shall be the same as the Oklahoma resident annual hunting license fee. The total number of annual combination hunting and fishing landowner licenses issued shall not exceed one license for each eighty (80) acres owned by the

1 landowner or operated by the tenant. Evidence of ownership or
2 tenancy and sibling or lineal ascending or descending relations, if
3 requested, shall be provided to the Department of Wildlife
4 Conservation.

1. For purposes of this subsection:

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- a. "landowner" means a resident owner of farm or ranch

 land of eighty (80) acres or more located in the State

 of Oklahoma, and
- b. "tenant" means an individual who is actively engaged in the agricultural operation of eighty (80) acres or more of Oklahoma farm or ranch land for the purpose of producing agricultural commodities or livestock and who:
 - (1) has a substantial financial investment in the production of agricultural commodities or livestock on such farm or ranch land and the potential to realize substantial financial benefit from such production, or
 - is a bona fide manager having an overall responsibility to direct, supervise and conduct such agricultural operation and has the potential to realize substantial benefit from such production in the form of salary, shares of such production or some other economic incentive based

1	upon such production. Evidence of tenancy, if
2	requested, shall be provided to the Department
3	and may include, but is not limited to, natural
4	resource conservation services records, farm
5	service agency records or written agricultural
6	contract or lease documentation.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
