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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless
22	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. A state agency shall not enact by rule, order or other means
24	any vaccination requirement for any member of the general public or

- discriminate against or civilly, criminally or administratively
  penalize any member of the general public who declines to be
  vaccinated or who declines to vaccinate his or her children, except
- 4 as provided by:

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- 5 | 1. Section 411 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 2. Rules promulgated by the State Commissioner of Health
  governing hospital standards as authorized by Sections 1-705 and 1707 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 9 3. Sections 1210.191 through 1210.195 and Sections 3243 and 10 3244 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; or
  - 4. Subsection B of this section.
- B. For purposes of this section, "state agency" means any office, department, board, commission or institution of the executive branch of state government. State agency does not include:
  - 1. Any county, municipality or public trust;
- Any hospital or health care facility owned by the state or 17 by a county, municipality or public trust including, but not limited 18 to, the University Hospitals Authority, the University Hospitals 19 Trust, the Oklahoma State University Medical Authority, the Oklahoma 20 State University Medical Trust or any entity under agreement or 21 contract to manage or operate any inpatient or outpatient hospital 22 or clinical facility, office or research building or other facility 23 or property of the University Hospitals Authority, the University 24

1 Hospitals Trust, the Oklahoma State University Medical Authority or the Oklahoma State University Medical Trust; 2 3 3. The Oklahoma Military Department; or 4. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or veterans 4 5 centers operated by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. C. A state agency, an entity excluded under subsection B of 6 7 this section or any person currently or formerly employed by or working on behalf of such agency or entity shall not be liable for 9 any damages incurred by a person diagnosed with a communicable 10 disease when the person chose not to be vaccinated or for 11 vaccination side effects when the person received a vaccination. 12 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 14 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
