An Act relating to agriculture; requiring the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to keep certain electronic mail addresses; prohibiting the release of certain electronic mail addresses unless ordered by certain courts; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-4e of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall keep confidential the electronic mail addresses provided to the Department through any online licensing program or similar electronic licensing system. The electronic mail addresses shall not be releasable pursuant to the Open Records Act absent an order by a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
