An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 723, which relates to evidentiary issues in certain homicide cases; modifying list of statutory references; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Evidence in homicide cases

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 723, is amended to read as follows:

Section 723. Any offense committed pursuant to the provisions of Sections Section 652 and 713, 701.7, 701.8, 711 or 716 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title does not require proof that the person engaging in the conduct had knowledge or should have had knowledge that the victim of the underlying offense was pregnant or that the offender intended to cause the death or bodily injury to the unborn child.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
