As used in this section, "social-emotional learning" is the 16 process through which children and adults understand and manage 17 emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for 18 others, establish and maintain positive relationships and make 19 responsible decisions. 20 Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, each school district 21 in the state may provide age-appropriate instruction of social-22 emotional learning at the option of the local school district. 23 C. The State Department of Education may create or offer

accurate instructional materials for social-emotional learning

2	to create or implement its own social-emotional learning education
