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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 220.1 of Title 61, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. For purposes of this section "design-build" means a project
17	delivery method in which one entity works under a single contract
18	with the project owner to provide design and construction services.
19	B. A conservancy district formed pursuant to Section 541 of
20	Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a municipality, a county, a
21	public trust, and any other political subdivision in this state that
22	operates a public water supply system or wastewater treatment or
23	collection system is authorized to utilize design-build as a project
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delivery method for public water supply and wastewater treatment
 facilities and wastewater collection systems.

C. No later than November 1, 2022, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality shall incorporate into its administrative rules a flexible permitting process to allow the utilization by the entities identified in subsection B of this section of the designbuild project delivery method for public water supply and wastewater treatment facilities and wastewater collection systems.

9 D. In the interim between the effective date of this act and 10 promulgation of rules, the Department may authorize no more than 11 five pilot projects in which the entities identified in subsection B 12 of this section may utilize the design-build project delivery method 13 for public water supply and wastewater treatment facilities and 14 wastewater collection systems, and the Department may use the 15 results to promulgate rules.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
