NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 15-133 of Title 47, unless there 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 For the purpose of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means 17 the discriminatory use of the fact that a person rides a motorcycle 18 or wears motorcycle-related paraphernalia as a factor in deciding to 19 stop and question, take enforcement action, arrest, or search a 20 person or vehicle with or without a legal basis under the United 21 States Constitution or the Oklahoma State Constitution. Law 22 enforcement agencies shall not engage in motorcycle profiling in 23 this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
