9 An Act relating to the Human Services Disbursing
10 Fund; amending 56 O.S. 2011, Section 224, as amended
11 by Section 236, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (56 O.S.
12 Supp. 2018, Section 224), which relates to creation
13 of fund; abolishing fund as of certain date and
14 transferring revenue therein; providing an effective
15 date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2011, Section 224, as
18 amended by Section 236, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (56 O.S. Supp.
19 2018, Section 224), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 224. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
21 revolving fund for the Commission for Human Services, to be
22 designated the "Human Services Disbursing Fund", provided that the
23 fund may be designated by fiscal year designations as the Commission
24 may determine. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to
fiscal year limitations. The fund shall consist of receipts from
the federal government, monies appropriated to the Department of

1 Human Services by the State Legislature, and other receipts of the
2 Department of Human Services as shall be directed by the Commission
3 for Human Services. All monies accruing to the credit of ~~said~~ the
4 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
5 Commission for Human Services as may be necessary in order to carry
6 out the duties imposed upon the ~~said~~ Commission by law, provided
7 that expenditures shall not be made from the Human Services
8 Disbursing Fund to pay any obligation for which there exists
9 authorization for payment from the Oklahoma Medical Center
10 Disbursing Fund or the Human Services Medical and Assistance Fund.
11 Expenditures from the Human Services Disbursing Fund shall be made
12 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
13 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
14 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. The Human Services
15 Disbursing Fund shall be abolished on July 1, 2019, and any funds
16 therein on that date shall be transferred to the General Revenue
17 Fund.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
