6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to license plates; amending 47 O.S.
8 2011, Sections 1135.2, 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last
9 amended by Sections 1, 2 and 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L.
10 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Sections 1135.2, 1135.3 and
11 1135.5), which relate to specialty license plates;
12 creating the Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate;
13 reauthorizing the Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate;
14 reauthorizing the Oklahoma Institute for Child
15 Advocacy License Plate; modifying design; creating
16 the Oklahoma Renewable Energy License Plate; creating
17 the Scottish Rite Mason License Plate; creating the
18 New State Brand License Plate; creating the Tulsa
19 Flag License Plate; creating the Oklahoma Veterans of
20 Foreign Wars Auxiliary License Plate; authorizing
21 entry into licensing agreement; providing maximum
22 licensing fee payment; creating the Transportation to
23 Transportation License Plate; providing for deposit
24 of portion of fee to the County Highway Fund;
creating the Blue Star Mothers License Plate;
authorizing entry into licensing agreement; providing
maximum licensing fee payment; creating the
Stillwater Public Schools License Plate; authorizing
entry into licensing agreement; providing maximum
licensing fee payment; creating the Oklahoma Golf
License Plate; authorizing entry into licensing
agreement; providing maximum licensing fee payment;
creating the Paramedic License Plate; providing for
apportionment of fee to the Emergency Medical
Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund; providing for
design of plates; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
2 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
7 provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
15 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
16 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
17 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
18 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
19 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
20 amateur radio operator license plates.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
10 follows:

11 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
13 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
14 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
15 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
16 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
17 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
18 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
19 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
20 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
21 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
22 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
23 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
24

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
5 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
6 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
7 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

8 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
10 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
11 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
12 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

13 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
15 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
16 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
17 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
18 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
19 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
20 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
21 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
22 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form
23 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
24

1 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
2 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
5 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
6 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
8 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

9 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
11 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
12 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
13 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
14 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
15 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
16 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
17 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
18 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
19 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
20 of one (1) ton or less;

21 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
23 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
24 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such

1 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
2 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
3 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
4 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
5 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
6 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
7 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
8 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
9 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
10 provided by this section for special license plates;

11 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
13 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
14 the United States as being:

- 15 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
16 7, 1941,
- 17 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
18 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
19 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
20 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 21 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
22 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
24 registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
6 1944,

7 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
8 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
9 participation cannot be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
11 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
12 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
10 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
11 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
12 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
13 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
14 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
15 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
22 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
23 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
24 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a

1 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
10 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
11 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
12 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
13 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
14 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
16 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
17 education police department by either an identification card or
18 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
19 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
20 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
21 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
22 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
24 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
9 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
10 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
11 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
16 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
17 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
18 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
19 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
20 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
21 "WORLD WAR II";

22 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
4 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
5 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

16 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
18 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
19 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
20 be produced upon application;

21 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
23 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
24 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a

1 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
2 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
3 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
4 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
5 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
6 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
7 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
8 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
9 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
10 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

11 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
13 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
14 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
15 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
16 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
17 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

18 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
20 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
21 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
22 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
23 of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 ~~21.~~ 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
3 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such
4 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
5 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

6 ~~22.~~ 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License
7 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or
8 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
9 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

10 ~~23.~~ 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
12 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
13 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
14 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

16 ~~24.~~ 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons
18 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the
19 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Ninety-Nines;

21 ~~25.~~ 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman
23 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the
24 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers.

1 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat
2 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman
3 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
4 of one (1) ton or less;

5 ~~26.~~ 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
7 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the
8 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia
9 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

11 ~~27.~~ 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
13 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
14 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
15 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

16 ~~28.~~ 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
18 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
19 United States Secretary of Defense;

20 ~~29.~~ 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
23 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
24 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such

1 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 ~~30.~~ 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall
5 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator
6 serves and the district number;

7 ~~31.~~ 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
9 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
10 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
11 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
12 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
13 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
14 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
15 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
16 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
17 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
18 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
19 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
21 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
22 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
23 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
24 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans

1 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
3 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
4 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
5 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
6 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
7 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

8 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
9 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
10 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
11 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
12 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
13 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
14 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
15 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
16 the Tax Commission;

17 ~~32.~~ 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates -
18 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air
19 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must
20 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
21 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

22 ~~33.~~ 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
24 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons

1 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
2 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
3 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
5 Academy;

6 ~~34.~~ 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid
8 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the
9 Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a
10 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
11 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
12 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
13 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
14 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
15 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
16 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
17 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
18 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
19 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
20 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
21 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
22 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
23 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
24 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license

1 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
2 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
3 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
4 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
5 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
6 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
7 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

8 ~~35.~~ 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
10 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
11 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
12 Oklahoma;

13 ~~36.~~ 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
15 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
16 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
18 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
19 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
20 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
21 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
22 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
23 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
24

1 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
2 state;

3 ~~37.~~ 38. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
5 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
6 shall mean:

7 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
8 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the

11 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents

14 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
15 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

12 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
13 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
14 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
16 Columbus emblem;

17 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
18 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
19 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
20 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

22 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
23 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in

19 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
20 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
21 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
22 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

23 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
24 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept

1 applications for special license plates authorized under this
2 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
3 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
4 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
5 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
6 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
7 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
8 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
9 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

11 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
12 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
13 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
14 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
15 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
16 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
17 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
18 removed from the vehicle.

19 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,

3 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
10 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
11 follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,

3 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
4 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
5 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
6 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
7 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
8 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
13 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
14 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
16 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
17 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
14 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
15 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
16 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
17 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
18 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
19 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

20 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

1 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
2 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
3 Section 1104.8 of this title;

4 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
5 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
6 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
7 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
8 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
9 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
10 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
11 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
12 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
13 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
14 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
15 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
16 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
17 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license

15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
18 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

19 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
22 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
23 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
24 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark

1 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
2 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
3 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
6 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
7 each license plate issued;

8 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
9 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
11 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
12 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
13 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
14 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military

11 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
12 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
13 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
14 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
16 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
17 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if

18 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
19 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
20 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
21 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued
22 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
23 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
24 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street

1 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
2 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
3 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section 5
4 2368.32 of this act Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Two Dollars
5 (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Public School
6 Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for expenditure as provided in
7 Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 99. Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary License Plate -
9 such plates shall be designated to honor the Oklahoma Veterans of
10 Foreign Wars Auxiliary and issued to any resident of this state upon
11 proof of membership in the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars
12 Auxiliary organization in this state. Such persons may apply for
13 Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary license plates upon
14 proof of membership in the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars
15 Auxiliary organization. The license plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary
17 organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into
18 a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars
19 Auxiliary organization for any licensing fees which may be required
20 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
21 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Veterans of
22 Foreign Wars Auxiliary organization of not more than Twenty Dollars
23 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 100. Transportation to Transportation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to support county roads
3 and bridges. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
4 with the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma. Twenty
5 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be paid to the county
6 treasurer for the county in which the license plate was purchased to
7 be credited to the County Highway Fund created pursuant to Section
8 1503 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 101. Blue Star Mothers License Plate - such plates shall be
10 issued to any person showing proof of membership in an Oklahoma
11 Chapter of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc. The license plates
12 shall be designed in consultation with Blue Star Mothers of America,
13 Inc., Oklahoma Chapter One. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
14 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Blue Star
15 Mothers of America, Inc., Oklahoma Chapter One for any licensing
16 fees which may be required in order to use the Blue Star Mothers of
17 America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a
18 payment to Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., Oklahoma Chapter One
19 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
20 issued;

21 102. Stillwater Public Schools License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Stillwater School District. The license plates
24 shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the

1 Stillwater School District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized
2 to enter into a licensing agreement with the Stillwater School
3 District for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
4 use the school district's logo or design. The licensing agreement
5 shall provide for a payment to the Stillwater School District of not
6 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 103. Oklahoma Golf License Plate - such plates shall be issued
8 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the sport of golf
9 in Oklahoma. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
10 South Central Section of the Professional Golfers' Association of
11 America and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
12 the sport of golf in Oklahoma. The Tax Commission shall be
13 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the South
14 Central Section of the Professional Golfers' Association of America
15 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
16 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
17 provide for a payment to the South Central Section of the
18 Professional Golfers' Association of America of not more than Twenty
19 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

20 104. Paramedic License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 and issued to any person who is a paramedic. Such persons may apply
22 for an emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of
24 a paramedic license. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma State University Oklahoma City
2 Paramedicine Program and the state association of emergency medical
3 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
5 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
6 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
8 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
9 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
10 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

11 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
12 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
13 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
14 authorizing the special license plate;

15 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
16 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
17 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
18 Registration Act; and

19 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
20 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

21 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
