| 14 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 253, O.S.L. |
| 15 | 2014 (63 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 3112), is amended to read as |

| 17 | Section 3112. For the purposes of Sections 2 through 6 of this |
| 18 | act As used in Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes: |
| 19 | 1. "Aftercare" means any assistance provided by a designated |
| 20 | lay caregiver to an individual under this act after the patient's |
| 21 | discharge from a hospital. Such assistance may include tasks that |
| 22 | are limited to the patient's condition at the time of discharge that |
| 23 | do not require a licensed professional; |
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- 2. "Discharge" means a patient's exit or release from a hospital to the patient's residence following any inpatient stay;
- 3. "Hospital" means a facility licensed pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-701 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title;
- 4. "Lay caregiver" or "caregiver" means any individual eighteen (18) years of age or older, including next of kin, duly designated as a lay caregiver pursuant to the provisions of this act who provides by a patient to assist in managing the medication needs of the patient or provide aftercare assistance to a the patient in the patient's residence of the patient. A patient shall be authorized to designate up to three caregivers to assist the patient with his or her medication or aftercare needs; and
- 5. "Residence" means a dwelling considered by a patient to be his or her home, not including any hospital as defined by Section 1-701 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title, nursing home or group home as defined by the Long-Term Care Reform and Accountability Act of 2001, or assisted living facility as defined by the Continuum of Care and Assisted Living Act.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
