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24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1SECTION 1.NEW LAWA new section of law to be codified2in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.269 of Title 69, unless3there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on Interstate Highway 235 crossing N.E. 23rd
Street in Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Chief Jon Hansen
Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
bridge.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.270 of Title 69, unless 11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 12 The portion of U.S. Highway 270 beginning at the junction of 13 U.S. Highway 270 and E0640 Road in Dewey County extending southeast 14 to the junction of U.S. Highway 270 and E0680 Road in Dewey County 15 shall be designated as the "LaVern Phillips Highway". The 16 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 17 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.271 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on U.S. Highway 60 over Little Cabin Creek approximately one (1) mile east of Interstate 44 in Craig County shall be designated as the "Clyde Miller Memorial Bridge". The

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Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.272 of Title 69, unless 5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge located on State Highway 66 crossing Pryor Creek 7 approximately three-tenths (0.3) miles east of Chelsea in Rogers 8 County shall be designated as the "Veterans Memorial Bridge". The 9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 10 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.273 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on State Highway 44 over South Elk Creek approximately three and two-tenths (3.2) miles north of State Highway 9 in Kiowa County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Douglas Hanna Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.274 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
The bridge located on U.S. Highway 412A crossing over U.S.
Highway 412 in Delaware County shall be designated as the "Michael

"Mike" Dale Russell Memorial Bridge". The Department of
 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent makers bearing that
 name to be placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.275 of Title 69, unless 6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of U.S. Highway 69 beginning at the junction of U.S. 8 Highway 69 and W. Shawnee Street in Muskogee County extending north 9 to the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W. Fern Mountain Road in 10 Muskogee County shall be designated as the "2ndLt Faythe McGinnis 11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause 12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 13 highway.

14SECTION 8.NEW LAWA new section of law to be codified15in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.276 of Title 69, unless16there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of U.S. Highway 64 Business beginning at the junction of U.S. Highway 64 Business and W. Kalamazoo Street in Muskogee County extending northeast to the junction of U.S. Highway 64 Business and W. Southside Boulevard in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "Avalon B. Reece Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing such name to be placed on the highway.

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1SECTION 9.NEW LAWA new section of law to be codified2in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.277 of Title 69, unless3there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent 5 markers to be placed on certain roadways acknowledging Broken Arrow, 6 Oklahoma as a Purple Heart City. The markers shall be placed around 7 the city at the following locations: Highway 51 Eastbound between 129th East Avenue and 145th East Avenue, Highway 51 Westbound 8 9 between 193rd East Avenue and 71st Street, on the Creek Turnpike 10 going Eastbound between 129th East Avenue and 145th East Avenue, and on the Creek Turnpike going Westbound near Kenosha and the Highway 11 12 51 entrance.

SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.278 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on State Highway 183 crossing Calvary Creek south of New Cordell in Washita County shall be designated as the "PFC Jackie Lindell Elston Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

21 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.279 of Title 69, unless 23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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The bridge located on U.S. Highway 412 approximately one-half (0.5) mile west of N2820 Road in Garfield County shall be designated as the "Trooper Houston F. "Pappy" Summers Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

6 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.280 of Title 69, unless 8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of 10 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending 11 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove 12 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean 13 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall 14 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 15 the highway.

SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.281 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on U.S. Highway 69 crossing U.S. Highway 64E in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "LCpl Geoffrey Fisher, USMC Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

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1 SECTION 14. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 240, O.S.L.
2 2015 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.223), is amended to read as
3 follows:

Section 1698.223 The bridge located on State Highway 56 in Okmulgee County approximately five-tenths (0.5) of a mile one and one-half (1.5) miles west of the junction of State Highway 56 and S. Madison Avenue in Okmulgee shall be designated as the "Bill Milroy Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

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 SECTION 15.
 AMENDATORY
 Section 11, Chapter 216, O.S.L.

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 2017 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.259), is amended to read as

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 follows:

14 Section 1698.259 The portion of U.S. Highway 59 in LeFlore 15 County beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 59 and State 16 Highway 128 in Heavener extending north two (2) miles shall be 17 designated as the "Pearl Harbor Veterans Survivors: CBM Doyle E. 18 Winters, BM1c Jerry E. Roop and, S2c Donald G. Loe and AM1 J.D. 19 Barnes Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall 20 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 21 the highway.
