7 An Act relating to roads and bridges; designating the
8 Chief Jon Hansen Memorial Bridge; designating the
9 LaVern Phillips Highway; designating the Clyde Miller
10 Memorial Bridge; designating the Veterans Memorial
11 Bridge; designating the Deputy Sheriff Douglas Hanna
12 Memorial Bridge; designating the Michael "Mike" Dale
13 Russell Memorial Bridge; designating the 2ndLt Faythe
14 McGinnis Memorial Highway; designating the Avalon B.
15 Reece Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Jackie
16 Lindell Elston Memorial Bridge; designating the
17 Trooper Houston F. "Pappy" Summers Memorial Bridge;
18 designating the Deputy Sean Cookson Memorial Highway;
19 designating the LCpl Geoffrey Fisher, USMC Memorial
20 Bridge; designating the Veterans' Memorial Bridge;
21 designating the Eugene Woodrow Wicker Memorial
22 Highway; amending Section 12, Chapter 240, O.S.L.
23 2015 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.223), which
24 relates to the Bill Milroy Memorial Bridge;
clarifying bridge location; amending Section 11,
Chapter 216, O.S.L. 2017 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section
1698.259), which relates to the Pearl Harbor
Veterans: CBM Doyle E. Winters, BM1c Jerry E. Roop
and S2c Donald G. Loe Memorial Highway; modifying
memorial highway name; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.269 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located on Interstate Highway 235 crossing N.E. 23rd
5 Street in Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Chief Jon Hansen
6 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
7 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
8 bridge.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.270 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The portion of U.S. Highway 270 beginning at the junction of
13 U.S. Highway 270 and E0640 Road in Dewey County extending southeast
14 to the junction of U.S. Highway 270 and E0680 Road in Dewey County
15 shall be designated as the "LaVern Phillips Highway". The
16 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
17 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

18 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.271 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 60 over Little Cabin Creek
22 approximately one (1) mile east of Interstate 44 in Craig County
23 shall be designated as the "Clyde Miller Memorial Bridge". The
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1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.272 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge located on State Highway 66 crossing Pryor Creek
7 approximately three-tenths (0.3) miles east of Chelsea in Rogers
8 County shall be designated as the "Veterans Memorial Bridge". The
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.273 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The bridge located on State Highway 44 over South Elk Creek
15 approximately three and two-tenths (3.2) miles north of State
16 Highway 9 in Kiowa County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff
17 Douglas Hanna Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
18 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
19 placed on the bridge.

20 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.274 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 412A crossing over U.S.
24 Highway 412 in Delaware County shall be designated as the "Michael

1 "Mike" Dale Russell Memorial Bridge". The Department of
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
3 name to be placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.275 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of U.S. Highway 69 beginning at the junction of U.S.
8 Highway 69 and W. Shawnee Street in Muskogee County extending north
9 to the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W. Fern Mountain Road in
10 Muskogee County shall be designated as the "2ndLt Faythe McGinnis
11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
13 highway.

14 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.276 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The portion of U.S. Highway 64 Business beginning at the
18 junction of U.S. Highway 64 Business and W. Kalamazoo Street in
19 Muskogee County extending northeast to the junction of U.S. Highway
20 64 Business and W. Southside Boulevard in Muskogee County shall be
21 designated as the "Avalon B. Reece Memorial Highway". The
22 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
23 bearing such name to be placed on the highway.

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1 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.277 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located on State Highway 183 crossing Calvary Creek
5 south of New Cordell in Washita County shall be designated as the
6 "PFC Jackie Lindell Elston Memorial Bridge". The Department of
7 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
8 name to be placed on the bridge.

9 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.278 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 412 approximately one-half
13 (0.5) mile west of N2820 Road in Garfield County shall be designated
14 as the "Trooper Houston F. "Pappy" Summers Memorial Bridge". The
15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
16 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

17 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.279 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of
21 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending
22 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove
23 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean
24 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall

1 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
2 the highway.

3 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.280 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 69 crossing U.S. Highway 64E
7 in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "LCpl Geoffrey Fisher,
8 USMC Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 bridge.

11 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.281 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 81 crossing over West
15 Chestnut Avenue within the municipal limits of Enid in Garfield
16 County shall be designated as the "Veterans' Memorial Bridge". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

19 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.282 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of State Highway 72 beginning at the junction of
23 State Highway 51 and State Highway 72 extending south to the
24 junction of State Highway 72 and East 151st Street South in the

1 municipal limits of Coweta in Wagoner County shall be designated as
2 the "Eugene Woodrow Wicker Memorial Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 15. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 240, O.S.L.
6 2015 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.223), is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 Section 1698.223 The bridge located on State Highway 56 in
9 Okmulgee County approximately ~~five-tenths (0.5) of a mile~~ one and
10 one-half (1.5) miles west of the junction of State Highway 56 and S.
11 Madison Avenue in Okmulgee shall be designated as the "Bill Milroy
12 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
13 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that
14 name.

15 SECTION 16. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 216, O.S.L.
16 2017 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.259), is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 1698.259 The portion of U.S. Highway 59 in LeFlore
19 County beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 59 and State
20 Highway 128 in Heavener extending north two (2) miles shall be
21 designated as the "Pearl Harbor ~~Veterans~~ Survivors: CBM Doyle E.
22 Winters, BM1c Jerry E. Roop ~~and~~, S2c Donald G. Loe and AM1 J.D.
23 Barnes Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
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1 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
2 the highway.

3 SECTION 17. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
