13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2011, Section 197.2, is							
14	amended to read as follows:							
15	Section 197.2 It shall be unlawful to employ workers in any							
16	industry or occupation within the State of Oklahoma under conditions							
17	of labor detrimental to their health or morals and it shall be							
18	unlawful to employ workers in any industry within the State of							
19	Oklahoma at wages which are not adequate for their maintenance.							
20	Except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act, no							
21	employer within the State of Oklahoma employers of this state shall							
22	pay any employee <u>employees</u> a wage of <u>not</u> less than <u>Eleven Dollars</u>							
23	(\$11.00) an hour or the current federal minimum wage, whichever is							
24	greater, for all hours worked.
