6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; providing
8 requirements for the introduction of bills and joint
9 resolutions by members of the Legislature; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 452.16 of Title 74, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 In order to introduce a bill or joint resolution, the member of
16 the Legislature who intends to be the primary author of the bill or
17 joint resolution shall present to the applicable legislative staff a
18 signed statement disclosing the source of the language used in the
19 bill or joint resolution. If the language is derived from an
20 organization, state official or state agency, the name of the
21 organization, state official or state agency shall be disclosed in
22 the statement. If the source of the language is the primary author,
23 legislative staff or the law of another state that fact shall be
24 noted in the statement. At the time the bill or joint resolution is

1 transmitted to the primary author for introduction, the applicable
2 legislative staff shall attach the statement to the bill or joint
3 resolution. If the bill or joint resolution is introduced, it shall
4 have attached thereto the disclosure statement required by this
5 section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
