## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring board of education to spend at least sixty-five percent of its operational expenditures on classroom expenditures; defining terms; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-126 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. A school district board of education shall spend at least sixty-five percent (65\%) of its operational expenditures on classroom expenditures.
B. As used in this section:

1. "Classroom expenditures" means expenditures for activities directly associated with the interaction between teachers and students including, but not limited to, teacher salaries and benefits, classroom supplies, and instructional materials and services; and
2. "Operational expenditures" means all expenditures made by a school district board of education other than expenditures for capital construction or debt or bond payments including, but not limited to, the payment of interest on debt or bonds, and expenditures for facilities' leases and facilities' rental payments. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
