10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,  
12                   Section 4-115.2, as amended by Section 2, Chapter  
13                   152, O.S.L. 2016 (26 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 4-  
14                   115.2), which relates to address confidentiality of  
15                   certain registered voters; expanding scope of certain  
16                   class to include immediate family members; defining  
17                   term; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19                   SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-115.2, as  
20                   amended by Section 2, Chapter 152, O.S.L. 2016 (26 O.S. Supp. 2017,  
21                   Section 4-115.2), is amended to read as follows:

22                   Section 4-115.2   A.   The Secretary of the State Election Board  
23                   is authorized to promulgate rules to keep confidential the residence  
24                   and mailing address, upon application to do so, of individual  
                  registered voters who are members of certain classes.   These classes

1 shall be limited to the judiciary, district attorneys, assistant  
2 district attorneys, Uniformed Services members, law enforcement  
3 personnel and the immediate family of law enforcement personnel,  
4 correctional officers, persons who are protected by victim's  
5 protection orders, the spouses and dependents of the members of such  
6 classes, and persons who are certified by the Secretary of State as  
7 participants in the Address Confidentiality Program established by  
8 Section 60.14 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such address  
9 information shall be provided to a candidate or candidate  
10 representative or other lawful authority in anticipation or as part  
11 of a contest of candidacy or contest of an election as provided for  
12 in ~~Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title or as part of a  
13 petition challenge as provided by law. However, no information  
14 concerning the address of a certified Address Confidentiality  
15 Program participant shall be released by election officials to any  
16 person for any purpose except under court order.

17 B. As used in this section, "immediate family of law  
18 enforcement personnel" means a spouse, child by birth or adoption,  
19 stepchild or parent living at the same residence as the law  
20 enforcement personnel.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
