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1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
L2	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified		
L3	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 322 of Title 3, unless there is

1 a facility identified and regulated by the United (13)States Department of Homeland Security Chemical 2 3 Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) 4 program, 5 (14)a dam that is regulated by the state or federal 6 government, or 7 a natural gas distribution utility facility, (15)including, but not limited to, pipeline 8 9 interconnections, a city gate or town border 10 station, metering station, aboveground piping, a 11 regulator station and a natural gas storage 12 facility, or b. any aboveground portion of an oil, gas, hazardous 13 liquid or chemical pipeline that is enclosed by a 14 fence or other physical barrier that is obviously 15 designed to exclude intruders; 16 2. "Dam" means any barrier, including any appurtenant 17 structures, that is constructed for the purpose of permanently or 18 temporarily impounding water; and 19 "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft without occupants that 3. 20 is flown by a pilot via a ground control system or autonomously 21 through use of an onboard computer and other additional equipment 22 necessary to operate the aircraft and includes unmanned aircraft 23

commonly called drones.

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- B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, a person shall not intentionally or knowingly:
 - 1. Operate an unmanned aircraft over a critical infrastructure facility if the unmanned aircraft is less than four hundred (400) feet above ground level;
 - 2. Allow an unmanned aircraft to make contact with a critical infrastructure facility, including any person or object on the premises of or within the facility; or
 - 3. Allow an unmanned aircraft to come within a distance of a critical infrastructure facility that is close enough to interfere with the operations of or cause a disturbance to the facility.
 - C. This section shall not apply to conduct committed by:
- 13 1. The federal government, the state or a political subdivision of the state;
 - 2. A person under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction or on behalf of the federal government, the state or a political subdivision of the state;
 - 3. A law enforcement agency;
 - 4. A person under contract with or otherwise acting under the direction or on behalf of a law enforcement agency;
- 5. An owner or operator of the critical infrastructure facility;

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1	6. A person under contract with or otherwise acting under the	
2	direction or on behalf of an owner or operator of the critical	
3	infrastructure facility;	
4	7. A person who has the prior written consent of the owner or	
5	operator of the critical infrastructure facility;	
6	8. The owner or occupant of the property on which the critical	
7	infrastructure facility is located or a person who has the prior	
8	written consent of the owner or occupant of that property; or	
9	9. An operator of an unmanned aircraft that is being used for a	
10	commercial purpose, if the operator is authorized by the Federal	
11	Aviation Administration to conduct operations over that airspace.	
12	D. Any violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor,	
13	punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than Five Hundred	
14	Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not to	
15	exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
