13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified	
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9e of Title 36, unless	
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:	
16	A. For the purposes of this section:	
17	1. "Complementary and alternative health care practitioner"	
18	means an individual who provides complementary and alternative	
19	medicine services;	
20	2. "Complementary and alternative medicine" means a form of	
21	diverse health care services together with holistic-based	
22	alternatives, including, but not limited to, chiropractic care,	
23	massage therapy, acupuncture, nutrition and the use of natural	
24	supplements to enhance health and wellness; and	

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3. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Any health plan, including the State and Education Employees
Group Health Insurance plan, that is offered, issued or renewed in
this state on or after January 1, 2020, shall provide coverage for
complementary and alternative medicine.

8 C. The Insurance Commissioner shall promulgate any rules
9 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
