
A sidecar attachment providing a separate seat space within

 C. No rider of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
 scooter, or motorized bicycle shall hold to any moving vehicle for

D. No Except as otherwise provided by subsection E of this
<u>section, no</u> driver of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
