Any payments made to providers in the prior fiscal year for 20 home- and community-based services for individuals with intellectual 21 disabilities; and 22 2. A strategic plan for serving more individuals with 23 intellectual disabilities through home- and community-based services 24

including goals and progress toward achieving such goals.

2	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
