NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 521.4 of Title 37, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 A direct shipper's permit may be issued by the Oklahoma 19 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission to a winery licensed 20 in this or any other state as a wine producer, supplier, importer, 21 wholesaler, distributor or retailer. A direct shipper's permit 22 allows a winery to ship up to twenty-four nine-liter cases of wine

annually directly to an Oklahoma resident over the age of twenty-one

(21) years for such resident's personal use and not for resale.

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- B. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall promulgate rules governing the application, issuance and renewal of a direct shipper's permits, which shall include but not be limited
 - 1. Proof of current licensure in this or any other state as a wine producer, supplier, importer, wholesaler, distributor or retailer; and
 - 2. Payment of a one-hundred-dollar registration fee for original permits and a fifty-dollar fee for renewal permits.
 - C. With regard to shipments permitted by this section, permit holders:
 - 1. Shall not ship more than twenty-four nine-liter cases of wine annually to any person for their personal use;
 - 2. Shall not ship wine intended for resale;
 - 3. Shall ensure that all containers of wine shipped directly to a resident in this state are conspicuously labeled with the words "CONTAINS ALCOHOL: SIGNATURE OF PERSON AGE 21 OR OLDER REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY.";
 - 4. Shall report to the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws
 Enforcement Commission annually, by a method prescribed by the
 Commission, the total amount of wine shipped into the state the
 preceding calendar year;
- 5. Shall annually pay to the Oklahoma Tax Commission all applicable taxes due on sales authorized by this section to Oklahoma

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1	residents in the preceding calendar year. The amount of such taxes
2	shall be calculated as if the sale were in Oklahoma at the location
3	where delivery is made. Upon request the permit holder shall permit
4	the Commission to perform an audit of the permit holder's records in
5	order to ensure compliance; and
