9	An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.								
10	2021, Section 314, which relates to investigation of fires; modifying time period for start of								
11	investigation; and providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:								
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 314, is								
16	amended to read as follows:								
17	Section 314. The State Fire Marshal <del>and</del> <u>or</u> the chief of the								
18	fire department of every city, town or <del>village</del> <u>district</u> in which a								
19	fire department is established, <del>and</del> <u>or</u> the mayor of every								
20	incorporated <del>village</del> <u>city</u> or town in which no fire department								
21	exists, and or the sheriff of the county shall investigate the								
22	cause, origin and circumstances of every fire occurring in such								
23	city, <del>village,</del> town <u>district</u> or county by which property has been								
24	destroyed or damaged, and shall especially make investigation as to								

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1	whether the cause of such fire was the result of carelessness or
2	design accidental or intentional. Said investigation shall begin
3	within <del>two (2) days, not including Sundays,</del> <u>forty-eight (48) hours</u>
4	of the occurrence of such fire, and the said Fire Marshal shall have
5	the right to supervise and direct such investigation whenever he
6	deems it necessary or expedient. The officer making the
7	investigation of fires, shall forthwith notify said Fire Marshal and
8	shall within a week of the occurrence of the fire furnish to the
9	said Fire Marshal a written statement of all facts relating to the
10	cause and origin of the fire, and such other information as may be
11	called for by blanks provided by said Marshal. The State Fire
12	Marshal shall keep in his office a record of all fires occurring in
13	the state, together with all facts, statistics and circumstances
14	including the origin of the fires, which may be determined by the
15	investigation provided by this act; such records shall at all times
16	be open to the public inspection, and such portions of it as the
17	insurance commissioner may deem necessary shall be transcribed and
18	forwarded to him within fifteen (15) days from the 1st day of
19	January of each year. The officer making the investigation of fires
20	shall within a week of the occurrence of the fire complete a written
21	statement of all acts relating to the cause and origin of the fire
22	and shall within forty-eight (48) hours of the occurrence of such
23	fire report to the State Fire Marshal all civilian and firefighter
24	injuries and fatalities resulting from the occurrence of such fire.
