13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1.2 of Title 40, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. There is hereby established the "Oklahoma Department of
17	Labor Occupational License Database".
18	B. The Department of Labor shall develop and maintain an online
19	website that allows public access to all occupational licenses and
20	certifications required by the state. The site shall include
21	functionality allowing site visitors to search by each occupation
22	and view the requirements, qualifications and fees associated with
23	each occupation.
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1 C. The Department of Labor shall promulgate rules by which each state agency, board or commission or any other entity that regulates 2 an occupation in this state shall submit a searchable electronic 3 version of the following information related to the licensure or 4 5 certification of the occupation: 1. Qualifications; 6 2. Licenses or certifications issued; 7 3. Fees; 8 9 4. Examinations; 10 5. Continuing education; 11 6. Reciprocity; 12 7. Penalties; 8. Contact information for the regulating entity; and 13 Any other information deemed necessary by the Department of 14 9. Labor to carry out the provisions of this section. 15 D. Each state agency, board or commission or any other entity 16 that regulates an occupation in this state shall comply with 17 procedures promulgated pursuant to the terms of this section. 18 SECTION 2.
