9	An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 332.15, which relates
10	to the Pardon and Parole Board; directing members to uphold certain standards; requiring disclosure of
11	conflicts of interests; directing members to withdraw from participating in matters under certain
12	circumstances; making language gender neutral; and
13	providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 332.15, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 332.15. A. From and after <del>the effective date of this</del>
19	act September 5, 1975, no member of the Pardon and Parole Board
20	and/or their law firm or law partners or associate may represent in
21	a legal capacity any inmate incarcerated in any state penal
22	institution. If a member of the Pardon and Parole Board, or his <u>or</u>
23	<u>her</u> law partners or associate or any member of his <u>or her</u> law firm
24	undertakes the representation of an inmate in violation of this

1	prohibition the member of the Board shall forfeit his <u>or her</u> office.
2	In any case in which an inmate requesting a pardon or parole was
3	represented in a legal capacity by any member of the Pardon and
4	Parole Board and/or their law firm or law partners or associate
5	prior to imposition of a prison term, the Board member who
6	represented such inmate shall be disqualified from voting on such
7	inmate's request for a pardon or parole.
8	B. A member of the Pardon and Parole Board shall uphold and
9	promote the independence, impartiality, fairness and integrity of
10	the Board, and should avoid impropriety or the appearance of
11	impropriety.
12	C. If any Pardon and Parole Board member determines
13	circumstances would cause a reasonable person with knowledge of all
14	the relevant facts to question his or her impartiality in a specific
15	matter, or creates the appearance of impropriety, the Pardon and
16	Parole Board member shall disclose any potential conflict of
17	interest and shall withdraw from participation in the matter.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
