16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2011, Section 1011.10, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1011.10. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall apply
20 for any necessary waiver to extend health care benefits to persons
21 up to the age of twenty-three (23) years if the person is enrolled
22 as a full-time student in an accredited technology center school,
23 university or college in the State of Oklahoma. The provisions of
24 this section shall only apply to persons eligible for a premium

1 assistance plan offered by the Authority pursuant to the provisions
2 of the Oklahoma Medicaid Healthcare Options Act.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016."
