7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 59 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 46.4, which relates to the Board of Governors
9 of the Licensed Architects, Landscape Architects and
Registered Commercial Interior Designers of Oklahoma;
re-creating the Board; and modifying termination
10 date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 46.4, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 46.4 There is hereby re-created, to continue until July
17 1, ~~2023~~ 2029, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
18 Sunset Law, a board to be known as the "Board of Governors of the
19 Licensed Architects, Landscape Architects and Registered Commercial
20 Interior Designers of Oklahoma", hereinafter referred to as the
21 Board. The Board shall be composed of eleven (11) members including
22 six persons who are duly licensed to practice architecture and are
23 in good standing in this state, two persons who are duly licensed to
24 practice landscape architecture and are in good standing in this

1 state, two persons who are registered commercial interior designers
2 and who are active and in good standing and one lay member. Each
3 member of the Board shall be a qualified elector of this state, and
4 the architect, landscape architect and registered commercial
5 interior designer members shall have had five (5) years' licensing
6 or registration experience as the professional position requires in
7 this state. Re-creation of the Board shall not alter existing
8 staggered terms. Board members, other than the lay member, shall be
9 appointed for a period of five (5) years thereafter; provided, that
10 nothing herein shall affect the tenure of office of anyone who is a
11 member of the Board on May 31, 1957. A member may be reappointed to
12 succeed such membership. The licensed architect, landscape
13 architect or the registered commercial interior designer members may
14 be appointed by the Governor from a list of nominees submitted by
15 respective professional societies of this state. Membership in a
16 professional society shall not be a prerequisite to appointment to
17 the Board. The lay member of the Board shall be appointed by the
18 Governor to a term coterminous with that of the Governor. The lay
19 member shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Provided, the
20 lay member may continue to serve after the expiration of the term of
21 the member until such time as a successor is appointed. Vacancies
22 which may occur in the membership of the Board shall be filled by
23 appointment by the Governor. Each person who has been appointed to
24 fill a vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the term for which

1 the member the person shall succeed was appointed and until a
2 successor, in turn, has been appointed and shall have qualified.
3 Each member of the Board, before entering upon the discharge of the
4 duties of the member, shall make and file with the Secretary of
5 State a written oath or affirmation for the faithful discharge of
6 official duties. Each member of the Board and staff shall be
7 reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to the State Travel
8 Reimbursement Act.

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
