14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 168, O.S.L.							
15	2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3311.16), is amended to read as							
16	follows:							
17	Section 3311.16 A. The Council on Law Enforcement Education							
18	and Training (CLEET) is authorized to conduct full-time Basic Peace							
19	Officer Certification Academies and other law enforcement related							
20	training for individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law							
21	enforcement agency under rules established by the Council. <u>CLEET</u>							
22	may establish and certify additional law enforcement and criminal							
23	justice programs at state-supported technology center schools in the							
24	State of Oklahoma operating under the State Board of Career and

Technology Education for teaching pre-law-enforcement students between sixteen (16) and nineteen (19) years of age.

- B. The tuition and/or fees for attending the Basic Peace Officer Certification Academies and/or other law enforcement related training will be at a rate established by CLEET and approved by the Council. Tuition and/or fees charged under this section will be deposited in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund established in Section 3311.7 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statues this title.
- C. Individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law enforcement agency who are trained in the Basic Peace Officer Certification Academies will be required to meet minimum requirements established for peace officers as set forth in Section 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title. Any fees relating to meeting these requirements shall be the responsibility of the individual. Individuals applying for the Academies will be required to submit a fingerprint check to CLEET prior to acceptance.
- D. The Council is authorized to promulgate emergency rules to effectuate the provisions of this subsection section.
- E. Upon successful completion of the Basic Peace Officer
 Certification Academy, the individual's CLEET certification will
 become effective upon employment by an Oklahoma law enforcement
 agency. Employment and certification must be obtained within two
 (2) years of completion of the Basic Peace Officer Certification
 Academy.
