7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to Council on Law Enforcement
9 Education and Training; amending Section 1, Chapter
10 168, O.S.L. 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section
11 3311.16), which relates to CLEET authority to conduct
 training; allowing CLEET to establish and certify
 certain programs at technology center schools; and
 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 168, O.S.L.
16 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3311.16), is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 Section 3311.16 A. The Council on Law Enforcement Education
19 and Training (CLEET) is authorized to conduct full-time Basic Peace
20 Officer Certification Academies and other law enforcement related
21 training for individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law
22 enforcement agency under rules established by the Council. CLEET
23 may establish and certify additional law enforcement and criminal
24 justice programs at state-supported technology center schools in the

1 State of Oklahoma operating under the State Board of Career and
2 Technology Education for teaching pre-law-enforcement students
3 between sixteen (16) and nineteen (19) years of age.

4 B. The tuition and/or fees for attending the Basic Peace
5 Officer Certification Academies and/or other law enforcement related
6 training will be at a rate established by CLEET and approved by the
7 Council. Tuition and/or fees charged under this section will be
8 deposited in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund established in Section
9 3311.7 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

10 C. Individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law
11 enforcement agency who are trained in the Basic Peace Officer
12 Certification Academies will be required to meet minimum
13 requirements established for peace officers as set forth in Section
14 3311 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Any fees
15 relating to meeting these requirements shall be the responsibility
16 of the individual. Individuals applying for the Academies will be
17 required to submit a fingerprint check to CLEET prior to acceptance.

18 D. The Council is authorized to promulgate emergency rules to
19 effectuate the provisions of this ~~subsection~~ section.

20 E. Upon successful completion of the Basic Peace Officer
21 Certification Academy, the individual's CLEET certification will
22 become effective upon employment by an Oklahoma law enforcement
23 agency. Employment and certification must be obtained within two
24

1 (2) years of completion of the Basic Peace Officer Certification
2 Academy.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
