7 An Act relating to health care; creating the Access
8 to Health Care Equalization Revolving Fund; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-105g of Title 63, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
17 to be designated as the "Access to Health Care Equalization
18 Revolving Fund". The revolving fund shall be a continuing fund, not
19 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies
20 available to the State Department of Health. All monies accruing to
21 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted
22 and expended by the State Department of Health as authorized by law.
23 Expenditures from the revolving fund shall be made upon warrants
24 issued by the State Treasurer, based on claims filed as prescribed

1 by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2 Services for approval and payment. The Department shall ensure that
3 all monies deposited into the fund are matched with federal dollars
4 whenever possible.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
