20	performance of an act by an officer or department of the United
21	States, as established by a statute, lawful order, rule or
22	regulation of the United States or an agency hereof.
23	C. As authorized by the Uniform Time Act of 1966 as amended and
24	notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary by the
