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L2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L3	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1000.2, is
L 4	amended to read as follows:
L 5	Section 1000.2 A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby
L 6	re-created to continue until July 1, $\frac{2023}{2027}$, in accordance with
L7	the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate
L 8	the plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and
L 9	construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the
20	powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act
21	and in the respective licensing or registration acts for such
22	trades, or as otherwise provided by law.
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B. 1. Beginning July 1, 2013, the Board shall be composed of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, as follows:

- experience in the plumbing trade, of which one shall be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a journeyman plumber,
- b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall be an electrical contractor and one shall be a journeyman electrician,
- c. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
 experience in the mechanical trade, of which one shall
 be a mechanical contractor and one shall be a
 mechanical journeyman, and
- d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years' experience as a building and construction inspector.
- 2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4) years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original appointment of the member whose position is to be filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.

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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
