11	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
12	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; empowering certain regulation of certain disease related to cervidae;

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2.4F of Title 2, unless there is
20	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, the Oklahoma
22	Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall be the state
23	entity empowered to implement all policy of the state regarding the
24	

care, testing, and regulation of Chronic Wasting Disease and its
presence or lack thereof among cervidae in the state.

The Department shall, in consultation with no less than two 3 Β. 4 (2) out-of-state individuals or researchers reasonably considered by 5 the Department to be experts in the field of animal diseases, promulgate rules as needed to implement the provisions of this act. 6 7 No county or other state agency or political subdivision of this state shall enact or enforce any order, ordinance, or regulation, or 8 9 perform actions which conflict with, duplicate, or impede the 10 authority provided to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, 11 and Forestry pursuant to Section A of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
