6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; prohibiting  
8 victims of domestic abuse from posting bond under  
9 certain circumstances; providing for codification;  
10 and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 60.10 of Title 22, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A victim of domestic abuse shall be prohibited from posting bond  
16 on behalf of a defendant if the defendant has:

17 1. Been arrested for allegedly committing an act of domestic  
18 abuse against the victim;

19 2. As a result of the arrest, a pending felony charge for  
20 allegedly committing an act of domestic abuse against the victim;  
21 and

22 3. Been named as a defendant in two or more victim protective  
23 orders issued under the provisions of the Protection from Domestic  
24 Abuse Act.
