6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to feral swine; providing for  
8 creation of certain web based market place by State  
9 Board of Agriculture; requiring development of portal  
10 to connect sellers and buyers; authorizing the  
11 establishment and collection of user fees for certain  
purpose; requiring collected fees be deposited to  
certain revolving fund; authorizing the promulgation  
of rules; providing for codification; and providing  
an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-650 of Title 2, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The State Board of Agriculture shall develop and maintain a  
19 web based marketplace for the commercial sale of feral swine  
20 harvested in this state. Such marketplace shall include but not be  
21 limited to, an online portal accessible from the website of the  
22 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry that allows potential  
23 buyers of feral swine and feral swine byproducts to connect with  
24 sellers of feral swine and feral swine byproducts.

1 B. To offset the costs associated with the development and  
2 administration of the provisions of subsection A of this section the  
3 State Board of Agriculture is authorized to establish and collect  
4 reasonable user fees for the privilege of accessing and utilizing  
5 the web based marketplace described in subsection A of this section.  
6 All fees collected pursuant to the provisions of this section shall  
7 be deposited to the credit of the State Department of Agriculture  
8 Revolving fund created pursuant to Section 2-10 of Title 2 of the  
9 Oklahoma Statutes.

10 C. The State Board of Agriculture shall promulgate rules as  
11 necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
