 (\$250.00), but not more than One Thousand Dollars

 (\$1,000.00),
- b. if, within three (3) years of the violation, the Commission has previously assessed one civil penalty against the person or rail line under this section, an amount not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), but not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or
- c. if, within three (3) years of the violation, the

 Commission has previously assessed two or more civil

 penalties against the person or rail line under this

 section, an amount not less than Five Thousand Dollars

 (\$5,000.00), but not more than Ten Thousand Dollars

 (\$10,000.00).
- 2. The Attorney General, upon the request of the Commission, shall bring a civil action to collect the penalties described in this section. All penalties collected under this section shall be
