17	1. $\frac{1}{1}$ First, in the county of which the decedent was a resident
18	at the time of his $or her$ death, regardless where he $or she$ died.;
19	2. $\frac{1}{1}$ Second, in the county in which the decedent died, leaving
20	an estate therein, the deceased not being a resident of this state \cdot ;
21	3. $\frac{\text{In}}{\text{Third, in}}$ the county in which any part of the estate of
22	the deceased may be, where the decedent died out of this state, and
23	the decedent was not a resident of this state at the time of his $\underline{\text{or}}$
24	<u>her</u> death <u>-;</u>

4. In Fourth, in the county in which any part of the estate may be and the decedent was not a resident of this state, but died within it, and did not leave an estate in the county in which he or she died-; and 5. In Fifth, in all other cases, in the county where application for letters is first made. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
