An Act relating to cities and towns; holding property owners civilly liable to a municipality for certain
expenses or costs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-112.4A of Title 11, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
In addition to any liens or remedies available to a
municipality, a municipality may hold the owner of the property
civilly liable for any actual expenses or costs incurred by the
municipality for cleaning and mowing of property, dismantling and
removal of dilapidated buildings or in relation to abating a public
nuisance caused by an abandoned building pursuant to Sections 22-
111, 22-112 and 22-112.4 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes and
any other expenses as may be necessary in connection therewith.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
