10 An Act relating to rural broadband; requiring
11 broadband service providers submit certain annual
12 reports; authorizing the promulgation of rules;
13 requiring OneNet to provide certain information;
14 requiring Internet service providers to disclose
15 information on properties served and speeds of
16 service; stating that certain information remain
17 confidential; requiring Council to determine data
18 submission format; requiring use of third party to
19 collect data; requiring data be delivered by certain
20 process; providing for codification; and declaring an
21 emergency.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.203 of Title 17, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Broadband service providers operating in this state shall
submit a report containing a broadband network area coverage map to
the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Rural Broadband

1 Expansion Council no later than October 31, 2021. On or before
2 October 31 of each year, the report shall be updated through a
3 supplemental report that reflects changes in area coverage from the
4 preceding year. The Department is authorized to promulgate rules
5 for the collection of the broadband network area coverage map
6 reports.

7 B. OneNet shall provide the Department and the Rural Broadband
8 Expansion Council mapping of all assets and network coverage.

9 C. Internet service providers doing business in this state
10 shall disclose to the Department and the Rural Broadband Expansion
11 Council the properties they serve and the average minimum download
12 and upload speeds at which they provide residential and business
13 services to those properties.

14 D. The reports and information required to be disclosed in this
15 section shall remain confidential pursuant to Section 24A.10 of
16 Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Council shall determine the
17 required submission format of the data submitted under the
18 provisions of this act. The Department shall use a third party to
19 collect the data submitted under the provisions of this act. The
20 third party shall deliver data to the Department following a white
21 label process to remove information identifying specific providers.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
