## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; providing short title; making certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing exceptions; defining term; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as "Cailey's Law".
SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1700.1 of Title 21 , unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. It shall be unlawful for any person to award a pet or advertise that a pet may be awarded as any of the following:

1. A prize for participating in a drawing, lottery, contest, sweepstakes or other game;
2. A prize for participating in a fair event;
3. An inducement or condition for visiting a place of business or attending an event sponsored by a business; or
4. An inducement or condition for executing a contract which includes provisions unrelated to the ownership, care or disposition of the pet.
B. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any of the following:
5. A pet store, if the award of a pet is provided in connection with the sale of a pet on the premises of the pet store; or
6. A pet given away or sold in connection with any agricultural, educational or vocational program sponsored or sanctioned by the State Department of Agriculture.
D. As used in this section, "pet" means any domesticated animal normally maintained in or near the household of the owner of the animal.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
