13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
15	This act shall be known and may be cited as "Cailey's Law".
16	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1700.1 of Title 21, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to award a pet or
20	advertise that a pet may be awarded as any of the following:
21	1. A prize for participating in a drawing, lottery, contest,
22	sweepstakes or other game;
23	2. A prize for participating in a fair event;

- 3. An inducement or condition for visiting a place of business or attending an event sponsored by a business; or
- 4. An inducement or condition for executing a contract which includes provisions unrelated to the ownership, care or disposition of the pet.
- B. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
- C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any of the following:
- 1. A pet store, if the award of a pet is provided in connection with the sale of a pet on the premises of the pet store; or
- 2. A pet given away or sold in connection with any agricultural, educational or vocational program sponsored or sanctioned by the State Department of Agriculture.
- D. As used in this section, "pet" means any domesticated animal normally maintained in or near the household of the owner of the animal.
- 19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
