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1. "Vegetable garden" means a piece of property wholly located
 within a person's residential property that is used to grow produce,

2. "Residential property" means real property on which there is
a dwelling unit with accommodations for four or fewer separate
households and is further limited to the primary residence of a
person.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3033 of Title 2, unless there is 11 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided by law, a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of this state may not regulate vegetable gardens on residential properties. Any such local ordinance or regulation regulating vegetable gardens on residential properties is void and unenforceable.

This section does not preclude the adoption of a local ordinance or regulation of a general nature that does not specifically regulate vegetable gardens, including, but not limited to, regulations and ordinances relating to water use during drought conditions, fertilizer use, or control of invasive species. SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
