6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
8 authorizing the Corporation Commission to initiate
9 and conduct administrative proceedings in certain
10 manner; providing for fines; allowing for waiver of a
11 hearing; providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19 of Title 17, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Corporation Commission shall have the power and authority to
18 initiate and conduct an administrative proceeding against any person
19 for violation of any rules, orders or other requirements promulgated
20 or issued by the Commission, in accordance with rules promulgated by
21 the Commission, and in lieu of exercising the power and authority of
22 the Commission as a court of record. Under the administrative
23 proceedings the Commission may issue fines. Any person, firm or
24 corporation may after notice waive the opportunity for a hearing
under an administrative proceeding.
