16	no effect if, within $\frac{\text{five }(5)}{\text{twenty }(20)}$ years after the date of
17	filing of any judgment that now is or may hereafter be filed in any
18	court of record in this state:
19	1. Execution is not issued by the court clerk and filed with
20	the county clerk as provided in Section 759 of this title;
21	2. A notice of renewal of judgment substantially in the form
22	prescribed by the Administrative Director of the Courts is not filed
23	with the court clerk;

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3. A garnishment summons is not issued by the court clerk; or

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1 4. A certified copy of a notice of income assignment is not 2 sent to a payor of the judgment debtor. 3 B. A judgment shall become unenforceable and of no effect if 4 more than five (5) twenty (20) years have passed from the date of: 5 The last execution on the judgment was filed with the county 6 clerk; 7 2. The last notice of renewal of judgment was filed with the 8 court clerk; 9 3. The last garnishment summons was issued; or 10 The sending of a certified copy of a notice of income 4. 11 assignment to a payor of the judgment debtor. 12 C. This section shall not apply to judgments against 13 municipalities or to child support judgments by operation of law. 14 SECTION 2.
