10	An Act relating to schools; providing for recall and removal of school district board of education
11	members; providing for submission of a recall
12	petition; requiring petition to be signed by certain percentage of school district electors; directing the
13	county election board secretary to certify the number of signatures; providing for submission of a recall
14	petition for board members elected by board district; specifying manner of recall elections; permitting
15	candidates to be placed on ballot after petition is submitted; providing for codification; providing an
16	effective date; and declaring an emergency.

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-107C of Title 70, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. School district board of education members may be recalled
24	and removed from office in a special election held for that purpose

which shall be called upon submission of a petition to the secretary
of the county election board.

3 A petition requesting the recall election of a member of the в. 4 board of education of a school district shall be signed by twenty-5 five percent (25%) of the school district electors in the school 6 district, the percentage being applied to the highest number of 7 voters voting in a regular school district election in the district in the preceding five (5) years as determined by the secretary of 8 9 the county election board, who shall certify the adequacy of the 10 number of signatures on the petition.

11 C. In any school district where the electors of each board 12 district, rather than the electors of the entire school district, 13 elect board members to represent that board district, a special 14 election shall be called upon submission of a petition to the 15 secretary of the county election board requesting the recall 16 election and signed by twenty-five percent (25%) of the electors in 17 the board district where the recall election is requested.

D. Recall elections held pursuant to this section shall be conducted in the same manner as the election of members of the board of education for a school district. After the submitted petition is signed by twenty-five percent (25%) of the electors requesting the recall of a member of the board of education, candidates who meet eligibility requirements may file to be placed on the ballot for such office.

1	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
2	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
