8 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
9 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, which relates to city-
10 county boards of health; authorizing the county board
11 of health to create a city-county board of health
12 after a certain date; and providing an effective
13 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-210, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1-210. ~~There~~ Prior to November 1, 2018, there is hereby
18 created in any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population of
19 more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according to
20 the latest Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its
21 boundaries a city with a population of more than one hundred fifty
22 thousand (150,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial
23 Census, a city-county board of health composed of nine (9) members.
24 Beginning on and after November 1, 2018, a county board of health
may create in any county of the State of Oklahoma with a population

1 of more than two hundred twenty-five thousand (225,000), according
2 to the latest Federal Decennial Census, and containing within its
3 boundaries a city with a population of more than one hundred fifty
4 thousand (150,000), according to the latest Federal Decennial
5 Census, a city-county board of health composed of nine (9) members.
6 The membership of the Board shall be composed of five (5) members
7 appointed by the city council of such city, or city commission,
8 whichever applies, and four members appointed by the board of county
9 commissioners of such county. Each member shall serve a term of six
10 (6) years, except, that of the members initially appointed by the
11 city council, or city commission, whichever applies, one member
12 initially appointed shall serve a term of two (2) years, one member
13 initially appointed shall serve a term of three (3) years, one
14 member initially appointed shall serve a term of four (4) years, one
15 member initially appointed shall serve a term of five (5) years, and
16 one member initially appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years;
17 provided, however, that in any such city having a city board of
18 health created under its charter provisions, the members of such
19 city board of health and the tenure of the city board of health
20 members of the city-county board of health shall be coterminous with
21 the city board of health. Of the members initially appointed by the
22 board of county commissioners, one member initially appointed shall
23 serve a term of two (2) years, one member initially appointed shall
24 serve a term of three (3) years, one member initially appointed

1 shall serve a term of five (5) years, and one member initially
2 appointed shall serve a term of six (6) years. The appointing
3 authority shall appoint new members as the terms of office of its
4 initial appointees expire. Wherever a city-county board of health
5 is now in existence, the current board members shall be retained,
6 until the termination of their present appointment, by the
7 appointing authorities.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
