17	Any property that is deeded and duly recorded in the office of
18	the county clerk in which the property is located and all accretion
19	of such property is to be respected in law and shall not be claimed
20	as public land by any third party, including the Bureau of Land
21	Management or any other entity of the federal government.
22	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 352 of Title 60, unless there is
24	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any property that is deeded and duly recorded in the office of the county clerk in which the property is located and all accretion of such property shall not be claimed or used by any third party for any recreational purpose that is not agreed to by the legal owner of such property.
