6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school districts; amending 70 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 5-106, which relates to governing  
9 boards of school districts; clarifying reference; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 5-106. A. The governing board of each school district  
15 in Oklahoma is hereby designated and shall hereafter be known as the  
16 board of education of such district. Except as otherwise provided  
17 in this section, the superintendent of schools appointed and  
18 employed by the board shall be the executive officer of the board  
19 and shall perform duties as the board directs.

20 B. The board may contract with a superintendent for a term as  
21 mutually agreed upon but not to exceed three (3) years beyond the  
22 fiscal year in which the contract is approved by the board and  
23 accepted by the superintendent. The contract shall include all

1 other terms and conditions as agreed upon in writing by the board  
2 and the superintendent.

3 C. The boards of two or more school districts may contract with  
4 one superintendent to serve as superintendent of the school  
5 districts as provided in Section 4 5-106A of this ~~act~~ title.

6 D. No board of a school district having average daily  
7 membership (ADM) of fewer than five hundred (500) pupils shall be  
8 prohibited from allowing a superintendent to serve simultaneously as  
9 a principal.

10 E. The chief executive officer of the board of education of a  
11 district in which a public developmental research school is  
12 established shall be the director of the school appointed as  
13 provided in Section 1210.577 of this title.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
