NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 17 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Sarah Stitt 18 Act". 19 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 513, is 20 amended to read as follows: 21 Section 513. A. 1. When any prisoner shall be discharged from 22 the institution, the warden or superintendent shall furnish the 23 prisoner with proper and necessary clothing and a railroad or bus 24 ticket to the home community of the prisoner within the State of

Oklahoma, if it is not in the county in which the institution is located; and if the home community of the prisoner is outside the State of Oklahoma, the warden or superintendent may furnish the necessary tickets to the home community of the prisoner or the county in which the sentence was imposed; and if the inmate trust account of the prisoner does not have at least a credit balance of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), the warden, superintendent or Chief Financial Officer may furnish such additional sum from the petty

cash fund as will afford the prisoner Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

- B. 2. Funds necessary to provide said clothing, transportation and Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) allowed in subsection A paragraph 1 of this section subsection shall be drawn from a petty cash fund established by the Department of Corrections pursuant to Section 513.1 of this title.
- B. When any prisoner shall be discharged from the institution and the intended residence designated by the prisoner is in this state, the Department of Corrections shall provide the prisoner with relevant documentation to assist the prisoner in obtaining post-release employment, including:
- 1. A copy of the vocational training record of the prisoner, if
 applicable;
 - 2. A copy of the work record of the prisoner, if applicable;

1	3. A state-issued identification card issued in accordance with
2	the provisions of Sections 6-105.3 and 6-106 of Title 47 of the
3	Oklahoma Statutes, if obtainable;
4	4. A certified copy of the birth certificate of the prisoner,
5	if obtainable;
6	5. A Social Security card or a replacement Social Security card
7	of the prisoner, if obtainable;
8	6. A resume that includes any trade learned by the prisoner and
9	the proficiency at that trade by the prisoner;
10	7. Documentation that the prisoner has completed a practice job
11	interview; and
12	8. Notifying the prisoner if he or she is eligible to apply for
13	a license from a state entity charged with oversight of an
14	occupational license or certification.
15	C. The Department of Corrections shall promulgate any policies
16	necessary to implement the provisions of subsection B of this
17	section.
