18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.11 of Title 62, unless
20	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. There is hereby established the "Oklahoma State Government
22	Open Records One-Stop Initiative".
23	B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain an
24	online web presence at the web address OpenRecords.ok.gov. The site

1	shall allow the public to file a request for documents pursuant to
2	the terms of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
3	C. Upon finding that requested documents are open records under
4	the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act, the Chief
5	Information Officer shall retrieve and deliver the documents to the
6	requester in accordance with the procedures of the Oklahoma Open
7	Records Act.
8	D. Documents requested through the open records web portal
9	shall be delivered to the requester in electronic format.
LO	E. Immediately following delivery of the documents requested to
L1	the requester, the electronic material shall be made available to
L2	the public through the data.ok.gov web portal.
13	F. Nothing in this section shall be construed to change any
L 4	obligation of public officials to comply with already existing
L5	provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
L6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
